Legal history as basic subject of the study programme "law". Original sources of Slovene law and its historical framework - Inner Austria / Ancient Roman Empire of German Nationality: legal sources (local customs, codified law, regional and customary or statutory law), signs and symbols of law. Legal tradition and legal culture. Justice: concept and source since antiquity to present time. History of economics systems. Institutions - law creators and users.
