- the master thesis: 20 ECTS
- must pass 14 subjects (9 compulsories and 12 electives), individual research work and master thesis.
- The courses are implemented in English.

LARGE POSSIBILITIES FOR ENROLLMENT

Eligible students are those who completed the 1st Bologna cycle study program either in the field of law or in economics, international relations, public administration and similar studies in the field of social or human sciences (in the latter case, the students have to pass a probative exam organised by the Faculty).
